

#### No. 34 - Pat Sin Range

#### Site

The site is the forested ravines on the northern slopes of Pat Sin Range. The area is about 128 hectares.

### Date of Designation

5 February 1980

### Special Scientific Interest

The forested ravines are interesting floristically where rare species are known.

The stand of **Cunninghamia lanceolata** in one ravine is possibly natural.

## Degree of Hazard

There is a risk of fire damage.

# Recommended Protection Measures

The site is within the Pat Sin Country Park. Priority should be given to the protection of the site within the framework of country park services.
