








Sampans were common travel vehicles in the old days.</p> 	<p>1970 Causeway Bay, Typhoon Shelter</p>  <p>Causeway Bay has received many refugees from Fujian, some of them had become fishermen along Causeway Bay Typhoon Shelter.</p> 	<p>1966 Victoria Harbour</p>  <p>1966 Kowloon Fury occurred because The Star Ferry fare increased \$ 5 cents caused the public took to the streets to protest fare increases, causing riots in Kowloon lasting for two nights. Hong Kong government dispatched police repression, finally resulting in 1 death and 18 people were injured, 1,800 people arrested.</p> 	<p>1930 Kowloon-Hong Kong Island, Wala Wala</p>  <p>Hong Kong to launch a kind of electric motor boat, had become a common water vehicle between Hong Kong Island and Kowloon Peninsula. Also known as electric boat or water taxi of Aberdeen.</p> 	<p>1910 Sau Ki Wan, Junk Boats</p>  <p>Junk Boats in Sau Ki Wan. Iconic antique boats of Hong Kong Tradition.</p> 	<p>1880 Kowloon Yau Ma Tei</p>  <p>Simplest fishboats in 1880's Hong Kong, with original materials like wood or bamboos only.</p>

The electrical boat was named by the early natives for the sound "Walla Walla" when its engine tapping the water. The boat body was mainly made of wood, with an engine in the front, and the passengers sitting in the back.

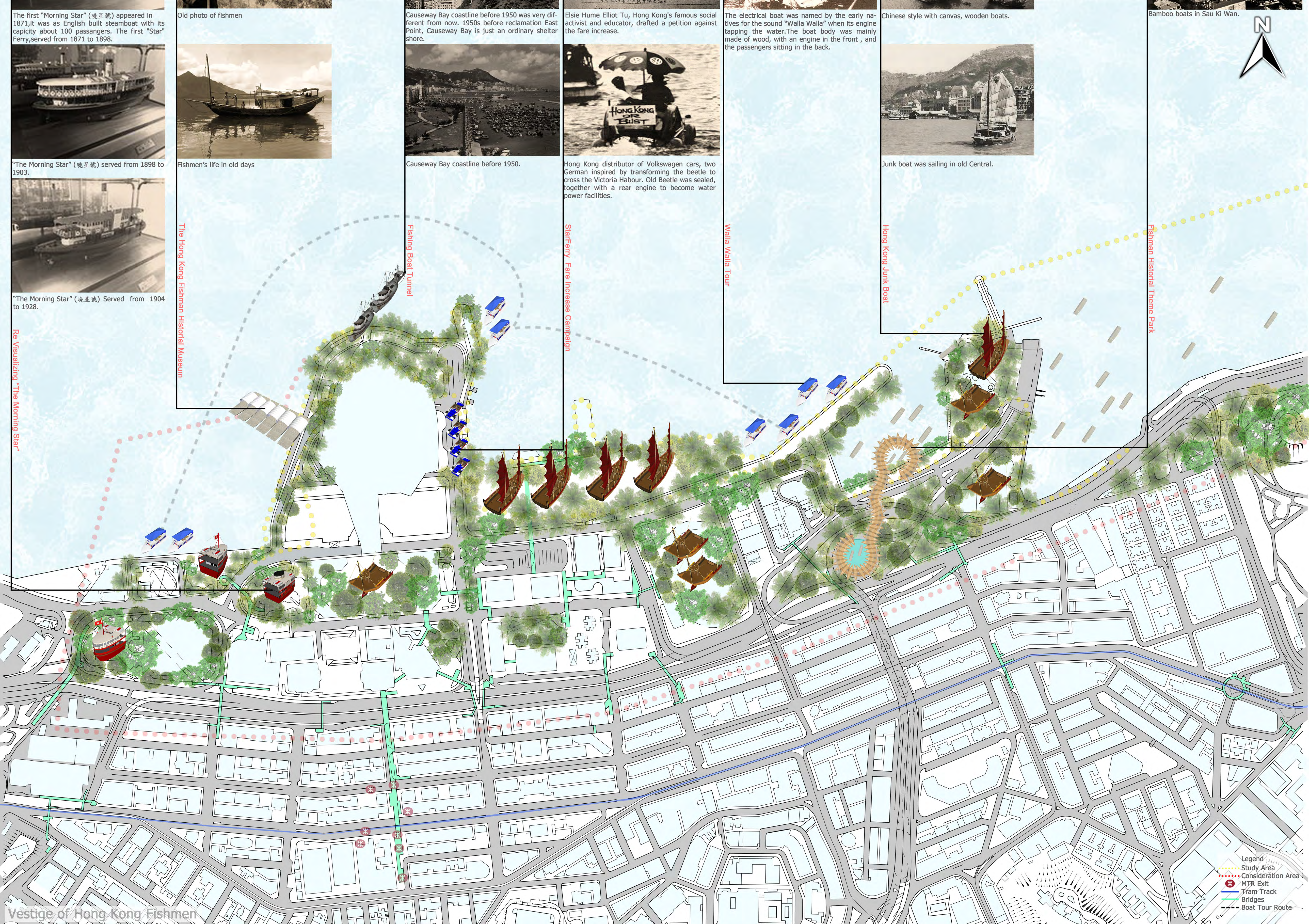


"The Morning Star" (晚星號) served from 1898 to 1903.
